This Month in Aviation History



V-173 "Flying Flapjack"

November 23rd, 1942... On this date, test pilot Boone T. Guyton took to the air in the most radical conventionally-engined aircraft ever built, the Chance Vought V-173. Flight testing of the V-173 went on through 1942 and 1943, resulting in reports of "flying saucers" from surprised Connecticut locals. Nicknamed the "Flying Flapjack", the V-173 nearly became the first V/STOL (vertical takeoff and landing) fighter, but due to Vought's preoccupation with the Corsair and Kingfisher, the program proceeded slowly during the war. The arrival of the jet age ultimately put and end to the V-173 program.

The good news... after a nearly 4-month delay, our brand new Evektor SportStar finally arrived! Skyraiders **John Risi** and **Chris Dillis** picked up N617EV in Kerrville, TX on November 5th, and flew her back to Erie. The 670 nautical mile journey took almost 8 hours... about an hour longer than expected due to a strong headwind most of the way. Leaving Kerrville mid-morning on the 5th, the two pilots stopped only once (in Plainview, TX) before completing their marathon flying session later that day.

Now the bad news... 10 days later 7EV ran off the east side of runway 33 and was significantly damaged as it crossed a drainage ditch.

Thankfully the student and instructor were not hurt in the incident, but the airplane will be out of commission for a while. The damage consists mostly of a wrecked nosewheel assembly and propeller. The broken parts will be removed, and replacement parts will be installed. The whole process should not take too long, and with any luck we could be reporting on 7EV's departure from the repair facility in next month's newsletter.
